- Created a Long Term Development plans for Athletes and Coaches (intended to be released Aug 2021)
- Created a Development Application form to ensure proper registration of Third Party Developers (2021/2022 Season)
- Created a Coaches Recruitment Form and Player Evaluation Process for the 2021/2022 Season
- Working on "Coach Them" Platform for all coaches to share drills and collaborate on Development

- Working on Video review platform for Coaches with help from EPP Director
- Working on Affiliation with Core Third Party Developers (SPEED, JLR hockey, Goaltending) with help of EPP Director and HL Director

## Brad Saunders, House League Director Report

- Unfortunately, the 2020-2021 House League season never started
- Return to the Hockey / Evaluation Day was hosted in early
   September, only ice time
- Firm Registration was approx. 213, plus dozens waitlisted (prior year ~ 350 players)
- Registration caps on divisions were set @ 40-50 to manage OWHA mandated bubbles
- Ramp System was used for registration/waiver/payments, will be streamlined more going forward
- Looking Ahead
- New HL Director will be needed, possible to split the role as Jr & Sr in future
- Direction on what might be possible for the 2021/22 season will likely come from the OWHA in late summer
- Team sizes, format of play (4v4), ice times needs, practice vs game mixes all TBD
- No messaging on DS and/or tournaments, no information on whether VAX will be needed to play/coach
- Should ice open up in the late summer, the board may approve sponsored development
- Bauer First Shift Program targeting a six week program in January to March
- 2021-2022 HL Registration could be open in mid-late June, website/social media/email blast, registration caps may be placed on divisions until further guidance is available
