## NON-RESIDENCY HOUSE LEAGUE POLICY

### EFFECTIVE

Created July 2017.

### PURPOSE

To govern the placement of non-residents in circumstances where the City of Mississauga policies allow for non-resident participation on MGHL House League teams.

### SCOPE

All levels House League ages (FUNdamentals/Tyke to Senior) of the organization.

### GUIDELINES

- Membership of the MGHL will be females of all ages in accordance with City of Mississauga definition of Resident.
- The City of Mississauga dictates, based on a percentage of membership, a maximum allocation of non-resident positions within the MGHL organization.
- The combined MGHL House League and Rep programs must not exceed the non-resident allocation.
- The allocation of non-resident positions available to House League is determined annually and only after Rep non-resident placements have been confirmed.
- Registration for non-residents will not open until August. The specific date will be determined each year.
- Acceptance of non-resident registrations will be granted to fulfill teams at each age level but is not guaranteed if teams are full. Non-residents who were accepted in previous years are not guaranteed admission in future years (no "grandparenting").
- Full fee, plus non-residency fee will apply (refer to fee schedule for non-residents)
- Allowance of non-residents in the MGHL House League program will be reviewed each year.
- Non-resident house league players trying-out for an MGHL Rep team will subject to the Non-Resident Rep Policy
- The MGHL reserves the right to seek proof of residency.

All decisions must comply with the non-residency allowance permitted by the City of Mississauga. There will be no exceptions to this policy unless approved by the MGHL Executive.
