MGHL BACKGROUND CHECK POLICY

FFFCTIVE DATE

Approved, Version 1.0: August 2016; Revised, Version 1.1: August 8, 2024

PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to comply with the Police Records Checks Reform Act (effective December 2015) as a volunteer organization. This policy also complies with the OWHA Screening Policy.

SCOPE

This Policy applies to all volunteers including all bench staff (coaches, assistant coaches, trainers, managers, staff, skills coaches, dressing room monitors and third-party skills coaches) at House, Rep and Women's League divisions (U7 through Senior) of the MGHL.

GUIDELINES

1.0 VULNERABLE SECTOR SCREENING PROCESS

The process for obtaining a Vulnerable Sector Check (VSC) is as follows:

- 1.1. Anyone who works with children on behalf of the MGHL over the age of 17 (including, but not limited to, head coaches, assistant coaches, trainers, managers, staff, skills coaches, on-ice volunteers, dressing room monitors and third-party skills coaches) must have a VSC.
- 1.2. Applications for a VSC are dictated by the relevant Police Service in the region of residence.
 - 1.2.1. For Peel Residents:
 - 1.2.1.1. Create or login to your account here: https://rec-check.peelpolice.ca/
 - 1.2.1.2. Follow the instructions to complete the online request. Upon submission, you will be asked whether to receive an electronic (PDF) or hardcopy. If you chose a hardcopy you will still need to submit a PDF via the OHF Screening Submission Portal before being added to any team roster. Images or other formats will not be accepted.
 - 1.2.1.3. Download a copy of the transaction receipt (this will also be emailed to you.) This may be required if the VSC is not completed in time.

- 1.2.2.2. Follow the instructions to complete the online request. The TPS OHF Agency Code is: 202309TPSONC78E2
- 1.2.2.3. Download a copy of the transaction receipt. This may be required if the VSC is not completed in time.
- 1.2.3. **Outside of Peel**: Search for Vulnerable Sector Check in your city of residence and follow the prompts to apply.
- 1.3. If a letter from the association is required as part of the application process, download the MGHL VSC Level 3 for Volunteers Letter.
- 1.4. There are costs associated with obtaining your VSC. The MGHL is not responsible for any costs incurred.
- 1.5. Certain offences showing up on the VSC will deem an individual ineligible to volunteer, as outlined in the OHF Screening Policy. Also, certain offences disqualify an individual to volunteer for a period of three years from the expiration of the penalty imposed. For more information, please contact the MGHL Vice-President.

2.0 RECORD SUBMISSION

- 2.1. Once the VSC has been obtained, upload the PDF to the OHF Screening Submission Portal. You will require your Hockey Canada Registry (HCR) Number to complete this process. Download the instructions on Obtaining Your HCR and Submit Your VSC Online.
 - 2.1.1. A Criminal Offence Declaration is included in the online submission process and must be completed.

3.0 SUBMISSION FREQUENCY

- 3.1. A VSC is required every three (3) years.
- 3.2. Annually, you must also complete the online declaration details on OHF Screening Submission Portal.

 You will be required to re-upload the PDF of the VSC and then complete the declaration details.
- 3.3. Any person identified above who has been away from the MGHL for more than one year is required to complete a VSC and Criminal Offence Declaration, submitted online via the OHF Screening Submission Portal, upon their return.
